## SUN61: Village of Cobleskill - Guided Historic Walking Tour

Spend an entertaining evening exploring the eclectic historical character of downtown Cobleskill. Hear about the early settlement of Cobus Kill, the American Revolution, a 1781 Raid, Fort DuBoise, Bull's Head Inn, War of 1812, Kellog's Artillery Company, Veterans' Park, the railroad, Hotel Augustan & other hotels, the first central school, Park Theater, & much more. Our tour is designed to end after sundown with the story of the November 27, 1900 night-time murder of nightwatchman Matthew Wilson. The tour meets at the public parking lot on the corner of Main (Rte 7) and Union Streets, Cobleskill.
