Join local historian Jeff O'Connor of Turning Point 1777 for a Guided walking tour of the Village of Middleburgh. Including prehistoric times in the surrounding valley, Vroman's Nose, Mohawk occupation, Wilder Hook, Adam Vrooman, 1756 fort, Palatines, the American Revolution, Middle Fort, Johnson Raid of 1780, post-war rebuilding of the settlement, 1786 church, a famous bank robber, architecture & more.
